### Teacher's Guide

**Skill Focus:** Recognizing sincerity, empathy, and accountability in apology language to strengthen social-emotional awareness.

### Differentiation Tips:

- Read each question aloud for auditory learners.

- Allow students to underline "honest" or "unhelpful" parts of each choice for visual reinforcement.

### Engagement Ideas:
