Plato's *Apology* records Socrates' defense at his trial. Use your knowledge of the text to decide whether the following statements are **True (T)** or **False (F)**. Then, rewrite the **false statements** to make them correct.

- 1. Socrates was accused of corrupting the youth and of impiety.
- 2. Socrates claimed he was the wisest man in Athens because he knew all things.
- 3. The Oracle at Delphi declared that no one was wiser than Socrates.
- 4. Socrates compared himself to a gadfly, sent to awaken Athens.
- 5. Socrates begged the jury with tears and his family to avoid a guilty verdict.
- 6. Socrates argued that fearing death shows false wisdom, since no one knows what death truly is.
- 7. After the guilty verdict, Socrates suggested his "punishment" should be free meals at the Prytaneum.
- 8. The jury unanimously voted to put Socrates to death.
- 9. Socrates believed it was better to die with integrity than to live dishonorably.
- 10. Socrates promised he would stop practicing philosophy if the jury demanded it.
