### Teacher's Guide

**Skill Focus:** This worksheet helps students recognize **appropriate and inappropriate topics** in group settings, teaching them how to **stay focused, respectful, and on-topic** in conversations.

### Differentiation Tips:

- Read the story aloud and pause to ask guiding questions after each student's line.
- Provide visual cues such as "Topic Cards" that remind students what the group is supposed to be discussing.
- For students who need extra support, allow oral instead of written responses.

### Engagement Ideas:

- Have small groups act out a similar conversation and stop when someone goes off-topic.
- Play "Stay on Topic" where students practice turning off-topic comments into appropriate ones.

### Extension Activities:

- Ask students to write two new sentences that would fit the group's topic.
- Encourage a reflection journal entry on why some topics should stay private while others can be shared in groups.
