Differentiation Tips:

- Read the sentences aloud for emerging readers and have students raise thumbs up for "Talk" and thumbs down for "Not Talk."
- Provide visual cues (happy face for "Talk," quiet symbol for "Not Talk") for students who need extra support.

Engagement Ideas:

- After checking answers, have students role-play two examples of "Talk" sentences to model friendly communication.
- Use puppets or classroom toys to act out good and poor conversation examples.

Extension Activities:

- Invite students to create their own "Talk or Not Talk" sentences to share with classmates.
- Make a classroom poster titled "Good Things to Talk About" using student ideas to reinforce positive communication.
