Teacher's Guide

Skill Focus: Students practice identifying **appropriate conversation topics** for different settings, helping them learn **context awareness** and **social flexibility**.

Differentiation Tips:

- Read the sentences aloud and have students respond by holding up setting cards labeled *School*, *Home*, or *Playground*.
- Offer picture prompts for students who benefit from visual supports (e.g., a classroom, a house, a park).
- Provide sentence starters and model examples before independent work.

Engagement Ideas:

- Create a "Conversation Corners" activity: label classroom corners *School*, *Home*, and *Playground* and have students move to the right spot after hearing each sentence.
- Encourage small-group role-play to act out appropriate conversations for each setting.

Extension Activities:

- Have students write one new conversation starter for each setting and share it aloud.
- Make a classroom chart titled "Where We Talk About It" and fill it with student-generated examples of setting-appropriate conversations.
