Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**

 - For **Grade 8**, challenge students to include personal examples or deeper insights about humility and purpose.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Begin with a brief class discussion about what "humility" means in everyday life.
 - Share images of ashes or crosses to make the reflection more visual and meaningful.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Invite students to write a short poem or acrostic using the word "ASHES."
 - Ask students to reflect on one small action they can take to show humility during Lent and share it on a classroom reflection board.
