Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For **Grades 8-9**, guide discussion on real-life examples of temptation.
 - For **Grade 10**, encourage students to relate the dilemma to larger themes like personal integrity or spiritual discipline.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Hold a class debate about what makes a decision "right" or "wrong."
 - Use role-play to let students act out Alex's choice and discuss consequences.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students write their own short moral dilemmas that could be discussed during Lent.
 - Connect to Scripture or literature passages about temptation and moral courage.
