Teacher's Guide

 - Begin class with a question: *"What do you think people today need to reflect on most?"*
 - Discuss how humility could be a strength in a world focused on self-promotion.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Assign a multimedia project: a short video, podcast, or art piece representing "modern humility."
