4. This ancient city in Jordan was carved into red rock cliffs
and contains famous structures like the Treasury.
5. This large statue in Thailand shows the seated Buddha
and overlooks the city from a hilltop.
6. This tower in Malaysia features two identical skyscrapers
connected by a skybridge high above the ground.
7. This temple complex in Cambodia is one of the largest
religious monuments in the world and features tall stone towers.
8. This river valley site in China contains thousands of life
sized clay soldiers buried with the first emperor.
