Teacher's Guide

Purpose: Helps students recognize important Asian landmarks while strengthening descriptive reading skills and geographic knowledge.

Teaching Tips

- Preview key words such as symmetry, monument, complex, and skyscraper.
- Encourage students to highlight clue words in each description before answering.
- Show students a classroom map to help them connect landmarks to regions.

Differentiation Ideas

- Offer a word bank for students who need additional support.
- Ask advanced learners to write one new description for an additional Asian landmark.
- Pair English learners with a partner to discuss each clue before writing.

Engagement Ideas

- Allow students to vote on which landmark they would most like to visit and explain why.
- Turn the clues into a quick guessing game before completing the worksheet.

Extension Activities

- Have students research one landmark and write three new facts about its history or design.
- Connect the activity to art by letting students draw a simple sketch of one landmark.
