## Kind Request Scenes Answer Key

### Sample Responses:

1. "Excuse me, Mrs. Green, can you please help me with this math step?"
2. "Excuse me, may I please have another fork?"
3. "Can you please show me how to play? I'd like to join."
4. "Excuse me, could you help me find a book about volcanoes?"
5. "May I please get another sheet of paper and a brush that doesn't roll?"

### Teacher's Guide:

- **Differentiation Tips:** Provide sentence starters such as "Excuse me, can you please..." or "May I please..." for students who need more structure. For emerging writers, allow them to verbally share their answers.
- **Engagement Strategies:** Role-play each scenario in pairs or small groups. Have students practice tone, eye contact, and body language while asking for help.
