### Sample Responses:

1. my teacher

### Teacher's Guide:

- **Differentiation Tips:** Offer a word bank with prompts such as "teacher," "classmate," "parent," and "counselor" for students needing extra support. For students with writing challenges, allow oral responses or sentence completion with pre-cut phrase cards.
- **Engagement Strategies:** Model each sentence aloud, demonstrating a calm and polite tone. Encourage students to share one sentence with a partner or in a group circle.
- **Extension Ideas:** Create a "Help Wall" where students write examples of when they asked for help and how it made them feel. Reinforce the idea that asking for help builds confidence and teamwork.
