Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Reinforces natural use of **at**, **in**, and **on** within conversational and situational contexts, helping students understand prepositions of **time** and **place** in dialogue.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide context clues by asking students to visualize where and when each scene happens.
 - Allow emerging learners to use a preposition reference chart before writing.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have pairs act out the completed dialogue to build fluency and reinforce real-world language use.
 - Let students record their own dialogues using the same prepositions in new contexts (school, weekend, vacation).
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Challenge students to rewrite the conversation in text-message form, keeping prepositions accurate and natural.
 - Ask them to write a short new dialogue using all three prepositions at least twice, highlighting how tone and setting affect usage.
