Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Reinforces practical understanding of **at**, **in**, and **on** in authentic writing contexts such as digital communication and informal speech.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For developing learners, highlight or color-code all prepositions before correction to guide focus.
 - Allow advanced students to explain how context changes meaning (e.g., "at home" vs. "in my home").
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn the worksheet into a "Grammar Inbox" roleplay where students reply to messages using correct grammar.
 - Create a class "Error Hunt Board" where students post funny but teachable at/in/on mix-ups they find online or in daily life.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students write their own realistic text or email using all three prepositions correctly.
 - Encourage peer editing by swapping messages and checking for tone and accuracy in preposition use.
