Atlantic Ocean's Importance Answer Key

Answers will vary, but strong responses should include points such as:

- The Atlantic Ocean is a major route for **trade**, allowing ships to carry goods between continents.
- The Atlantic connects different **cultures**, leading to the exchange of ideas, food, languages, and traditions.
- The Atlantic supports large **ecosystems**, including fish, whales, sea turtles, and many plants that depend on ocean currents and habitats.
- Mention of features such as the Gulf Stream, busy shipping routes, or diverse marine life strengthens the explanation.

- Review what makes a strong paragraph before students begin, including clarity, details, and examples.

Differentiation Tips

- Provide sentence starters for students who need structure, such as "The Atlantic Ocean is important because..."

- Challenge advanced learners to include three separate areas of importance in their response.

Engagement Ideas

- Start with a quick map activity showing how many countries border the Atlantic.
