 - **Opinion:** *I think those moments were the happiest I've ever been.*
 - **Author's Purpose: Entertain** – Through a nostalgic narrative expressing emotion and memory.

- **Fact:** *Sharks have been around for over 400 million years.*
 - **Opinion:** *Media often portrays them as mindless killers.*
 - **Author's Purpose: Inform** – The passage provides factual info and aims to correct a misconception.

- **Fact:** *Learning how to budget, save, and understand credit cards is far more useful than memorizing algebra formulas...* (the content is factual though phrased in a persuasive way).
- **Opinion:** *Every student should be required to take a financial literacy course.*
- **Author's Purpose: Persuade** – The author argues for a change in education policy.
