Spotting Textual Clues Answer Key

1. Headline: "The Case for a Four-Day Workweek"

Clue 1: Use of persuasive language like *"it's time to rethink the 40-hour standard"*

Clue 2: Citing studies from Iceland and New Zealand showing *higher productivity and lower burnout*

Author's Purpose: Persuade

To convince the reader to support a shift to a four-day workweek by presenting benefits and evidence.

2. Article Excerpt

Clue 1: Use of statistics like *"deforestation increased by 22%"*

Clue 2: Scientific tone and language, including phrases like *"tipping point"* and *"irreversible damage"*

Author's Purpose: Inform

To present facts and raise awareness about deforestation in the Amazon Rainforest.

3. Story Excerpt

Clue 1: Descriptive imagery such as *"the silence around him was thick"* and *"a hawk screamed"*

Clue 2: Focus on a character's inner journey and tension: *"the hardest part of the journey was still ahead"*

Author's Purpose: Entertain

To engage the reader with a dramatic and immersive narrative.
