Teacher's Guide

Skill Focus:

- Reinforces the difference between adjectives (bad) and adverbs (badly).
- Builds recognition of how linking verbs connect to adjectives and action verbs connect to adverbs.

Differentiation Tips:

- Provide two labeled baskets or sides of the board for tactile learners to "sort" sentence cards.
- Use color coding: blue for **bad**, green for **badly**.

Engagement Ideas:
