Instructions: Pretend you are a **time-traveling revolutionary courier**, sent across France in 1789 to deliver secret messages. Follow the clues below to figure out which **cities, regions, or landmarks** to label on your **blank map of France**. Label each one with a number (1-10) on your map and write the name next to that number in the list below.

Your Mission - Map Clues

1. Start your journey in the city where the Bastille once stood, and where the Revolution began.
2. Travel southeast to the city on the Mediterranean coast, known today for its multicultural port and lively French rap scene.
3. Head north to a city famous for mustard and vineyards, in the region of Burgundy.
4. Mark the region where the storming of the Bastille sparked a wave of revolts known as the Great Fear. (Hint: It's where many rural peasants lived in central France.)
5. Near Paris, label the former royal residence of kings and queens—where Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette once lived.
6. Now travel east to the region that borders Germany and was often contested in wars. It's known for its blend of French and German culture.
7. Label the northern port city known for its ferries to England, and as a site of French resistance in WWII.
8. Circle the region known for its sunflowers, lavender fields, and art inspiration for painters like Van Gogh.
9. You reach a city on the Garonne River in southwestern France, often called “La Ville Rose” because of its red-brick buildings.
10. Lastly, return to the capital and mark the iconic iron tower built a century after the revolution to honor French engineering.
