Digraph Scavenger Search Answer Key

Answers will vary, but may include:

- sh: shoe, shelf, shirt, shampoo
- ch: chair, chalk, charger, chart
- wh: wheel, whistle, whiteboard
- th: thermometer, thumbtack, thread
- ph: phone, photo, phrase chart

Teacher's Guide

- Begin by reviewing each digraph sound and giving quick examples. Encourage students to repeat the sounds.
- Before sending students on their scavenger search, brainstorm possible items as a group to support emerging readers.
- For differentiation, provide picture cards with common digraph items and have students match them instead of searching independently.
- For engagement, turn the activity into a timed scavenger search or let students draw the items instead of writing them.
- For extension, ask students to use two of their discovered digraph words in short sentences.
