### Teacher's Guide

- Review the target digraphs with students: **sh**, **ch**, **wh**, and **th**. Give a few oral examples before beginning.
- Encourage students to read each word aloud. Real words should sound familiar and make sense. Nonsense words may sound strange or not match any known meaning.
- For differentiation, allow emerging readers to tap each sound while decoding or provide picture cards of common digraph words to connect sound with meaning.
- For extension, have students choose two real words from the list and write short sentences using them.
- For extra engagement, turn it into a quick game: students earn a point each time they correctly identify a real digraph word.
