### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation:** If students need support, provide letter choices for the first sound (For cat: b, h, r) and have them try each one. If students are ready for more, challenge them to make a third rhyme for any three rows.
- **Engagement:** Use "sound swap" talk: students tap once for the first sound, then say the new word after the swap. Let partners read each other's rhymes aloud to check if they match.
- **Extension:** Students pick one word family (at, un, og) and write a short list of four rhyming words, then circle the one they like best and draw it.
