

## Write In Two Tones Answer Key

### Expected Elements:

- Informal paragraph uses **in back of** correctly and includes relaxed tone and conversational phrases.
- Formal paragraph uses **behind** correctly with precise, polished language and smoother transitions.
- Both paragraphs describe the same situation with a clear tone difference.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Understanding how prepositional choice impacts *tone, audience, and formality*.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For struggling learners, provide sentence starters for both tone types (e.g., "In back of the..." / "Behind the...").
  - For advanced students, challenge them to revise informal slang or phrasing in the formal version.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Let students read both paragraphs aloud and have the class guess which is formal or informal.
  - Use peer editing: partners underline tone words that make each version sound different.
- **Extension Activity:**
  - Ask students to create a mini "tone dictionary" listing other prepositions or expressions that shift between casual and formal writing.
