### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Distinguishing between **formal** and **informal** usage of prepositions by applying **behind** for structured, academic, or professional contexts and **in back of** for everyday or conversational writing.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Allow emerging learners to label each context (speech, email, essay) first before deciding which preposition fits.
  - Have advanced students explain *why* their chosen preposition fits the tone in a short note beside each sentence.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Play it as a "Formality Relay" where teams race to decide which preposition fits each context.
  - Read sentences aloud and have students hold up "B" or "IBO" cards to respond quickly.
- **Extension Activity:**
  - Ask students to write their own three sentences - one for a **speech**, one for an **email**, and one for an **essay** - each using the correct preposition for tone and setting.
