

School Play Tune-Up Answer Key

Edited Formal Passage:

During the school play, Ava waited **behind** the stage for her cue. The costumes were stored **behind** a long curtain, and everyone whispered so they wouldn't be heard. The lighting crew stood **behind** the tall backdrop, ready to shine the spotlight when the main character stepped forward. Even the director hid **behind** the sound booth to watch how everything came together.

Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Students practice improving writing tone by replacing **in back of** (informal) with **behind** (formal).
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For emerging learners, underline all instances of **in back of** before rewriting.
 - For advanced students, challenge them to identify and change other informal words to make the passage more academic.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students act out the scene using both versions to feel the tone difference.
 - Encourage peer editing by trading rewritten passages and providing "tone improvement" feedback.
- **Extension Activity:**
 - Ask students to write a short paragraph about a classroom event using **behind** correctly three times to maintain formal tone.
