Preposition Polish-Up Answer Key

Teacher's Guide

• **Skill Focus**: Builds accuracy in distinguishing **beside** (meaning *next to*) from **besides** (meaning *in addition to* or *apart from*) in extended writing.

• Differentiation Tips:

- For students who struggle, provide a pre-highlighted version of the paragraph where all prepositions are marked, and have them decide which are correct.
- Encourage advanced learners to explain why each correction was necessary in a short reflection sentence.

Engagement Idea:

 Let students work in pairs as "Editors" and "Writers." The Editor reads aloud while the Writer rewrites the corrected version, then they switch roles.

Extension Activity:

 Have students compose their own short paragraph (6-8 sentences) about a real or imagined school event, intentionally using both beside and besides at least three times correctly.
