Teacher's Guide

• **Skill Focus**: Reinforces proper distinction between **beside** (showing location) and **besides** (showing addition or exception) through guided sentence creation.

• Differentiation Tips:

- Allow students needing support to start from sentence frames (e.g., "I sat beside..." or "Besides playing...").
- For advanced learners, have them combine both prepositions into one complex sentence.

Engagement Idea:

o Turn it into a "Speed Write" challenge where students have two minutes per pair to create vivid, context-rich sentences.

• Extension Activity:

 Ask students to write a short paragraph (5-7 sentences) using both beside and besides at least twice, highlighting each usage in different colors.
