Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Students learn to distinguish **between** (used for two separate items) and **among** (used for groups or three or more).
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Offer visuals like pictures of pairs vs. groups for tactile learners.
 - Provide sentence frames for emerging writers: "The book is _____ the two pencils."
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students act out "between" and "among" positions using classroom objects.
 - Turn it into a relay game where partners race to match correct pairs.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Ask pairs to create three original sentence pairs of their own using both prepositions correctly.
 - Have students explain *why* they chose **between** or **among** for each sentence.
