Directions: Read the **two brief reports** below about the same event, a city's plan to build a new community park. Each passage presents the story from a slightly different perspective. After reading both, answer the questions that follow to compare **tone**, **word choice**, and **focus**.

Report A: "Green Space Victory for Families"

City leaders have **finally delivered** on their promise to give families more outdoor spaces. The new community park, set to open next spring, will include **beautiful walking trails**, a **modern playground**, and **eco-friendly landscaping**. Local parents have called it a **long-overdue win** for the community's children. The project demonstrates how the city is **listening to families** and investing in a **healthier, happier future**.

Report B: "Taxpayers Foot the Bill for Costly Park Project"

City officials have approved a **controversial** park project that will cost **over \$3 million** in taxpayer money. Critics argue that the funds could be better spent on **road repairs** and **school improvements**. Some residents worry that the plan is more about **political image** than actual community need. The park, expected to open next spring, has become a **divisive issue** in upcoming local elections.

3. Which report focuses more on **positive community benefits**? Which one focuses more on **cost and controversy**?
4. If you were reading these two reports separately, how might each one shape your **opinion** of the park project?
