Box Of Traditions Answer Key

1. **Main Idea:** Boxing Day began as a day to give gifts to workers and has become a celebration of generosity and community.
2. **Supporting Details (past):** Wealthy families gave boxes of gifts and food to servants; churches collected donations for the poor.
3. **Supporting Details (present):** People donate to charities, volunteer, enjoy sports, and shop at post-holiday sales.
4. **Explanation:** It reminds people to keep the spirit of giving alive even after Christmas.

Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Strengthen comprehension by identifying the main idea and supporting details in an informational holiday passage.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - *Grades 5-6:* Have students highlight the main idea in one color and underline supporting details in another for visual clarity.
 - *Lower grades:* Read the passage aloud and discuss the difference between "main idea" and "detail."
- **Engagement Idea:** Turn the passage into a "Main Idea Mystery Hunt" by hiding main idea clues around the classroom for students to match to paragraphs.
- **Extension Activity:** Ask students to write their own paragraph about another holiday's main idea and details, comparing it to Boxing Day's theme of generosity.
