Out-of-Order Events

- A. The U.S. Supreme Court issues a ruling in Plessy v. Ferguson, allowing "separate but equal" public facilities.
- B. The Supreme Court declares in Brown v. Board of Education that segregated public schools are unconstitutional.
- C. President Eisenhower sends federal troops to protect the Little Rock Nine as they attend an all-white high school in Arkansas.
- D. Civil Rights Act is passed, giving the federal government power to enforce school desegregation.
- E. Linda Brown's family files a lawsuit against the Topeka Board of Education.
- F. Many Southern states create laws and strategies to delay school integration.
- G. Brown II is decided, calling for integration to proceed "with all deliberate speed."
- H. Thurgood Marshall is appointed the first African American U.S. Supreme Court Justice.
- I. NAACP begins challenging segregated education in courts across the U.S.
- J. The U.S. Department of Education reports that schools in some areas remain largely segregated by race and income.
