Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Read scenarios aloud and discuss vocabulary like *empathetic*, *considerate*, and *understanding* before starting.
 - Provide visual emotion cards to support comprehension of feelings described.
 - Allow verbal explanations of answers for students with writing challenges.
- **Engagement Strategies:**
 - After each question, hold a quick class discussion: "What might happen if we chose a different option?"
 - Encourage students to connect scenarios to real-life school or online experiences.
 - Use role-play for one or two scenarios to model empathetic responses.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Have students create their own empathy dilemmas with A-D choices for classmates to answer.
 - Reflect in journals about a time they chose empathy in a difficult moment.
 - Combine this worksheet with a class "Empathy Challenge Week" where students track kind actions they take.
