Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus**: Students learn to tell the difference between **by** (the *doer* or *agent* of the action) and **with** (the *tool* or *instrument* used).
- Differentiation Tips:
 - Provide real-life examples using objects around the classroom, like
 "The board was written with a marker" and "The board was written by the teacher."
 - For struggling learners, underline the *person* or *tool* first, then decide which preposition fits.
- **Engagement Idea**: Turn this into a "Tool Time Race" where students act out an action and classmates shout whether it should use **by** or **with**.
- Extension: Have advanced learners create their own two-sentence pairs: one using by and one using with-to show how the meaning changes.
