### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill focus:** Students hear and see **rhyming endings** in **CVC** words (same ending sound, different beginning sound).
- **Quick routine:** Have students tap and say each word slowly, then repeat the last sound chunk (example: pin, win, in).
- **Differentiation:**
  - Support: Read choices aloud; students repeat and point before circling.
  - Challenge: Students write a new rhyming word for the target after circling (example: log, fog, dog).
- **Engagement:** Turn it into a "sound check" game; students whisper the target word, then say the rhyme choice in a strong voice.
- **Extension:** After circling, students underline the matching ending letters in the target and the rhyme word (example: fog and log).
