## Permission Parade Answer Key

1. Correct - polite request for permission.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Helps students distinguish between *can* (ability) and *could* (polite permission or request).
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For struggling learners, model both forms in class conversations before independent work.
  - For advanced learners, challenge them to write two new sentences showing both *can* and *could* correctly.
- **Engagement Idea:** Have a "Permission Parade" roleplay where students ask for permission around the classroom using *can* and *could*.
- **Extension Activity:** Ask students to create a short dialogue between two characters using both *can* and *could* naturally in context.
