Teacher's Guide

- Use this activity to help students clearly identify **Ottawa** as the capital and distinguish it from other major cities.
- Encourage students to look for **clue words** like capital, west coast, French speaking, or landmark names.
- Can be completed individually or in pairs.

Differentiation Tips

- For Grades 3 to 4:
 - Provide short picture cards of each city and allow students to reference them.
 - Read clues aloud and discuss key vocabulary such as capital or port.
- For Grades 5 to 6:
 - Challenge students to write one extra clue for each city.
 - Ask students why they think Ottawa was chosen as the capital.

Extension Activities

- Students create a simple fact card for Ottawa and another major city for comparison.
- Assign a short paragraph explaining why capitals are important in any country.
- Invite students to design a mini travel poster for one of the four cities.
