### Teacher's Guide

- Let students check their completed sentences by rereading the whole factsheet.

### Differentiation Tips

- For Grades 3 to 5:
  - Pre teach bolded vocabulary and show images for support.
  - Allow students to work with partners to sound out unfamiliar words.
- For Grades 6 to 8:
  - Ask students to write an additional fact sentence using one of the unused words.
  - Have students explain why their chosen word fits each sentence.

### Engagement Ideas

- Create a quick class discussion on which facts surprised students the most.
- Let students mark the mountains, oceans, and capital city on a blank outline map.
- Encourage students to identify where the Inuit live using a classroom globe.
