Teacher Notes

- This worksheet highlights **proper capitalization of days, months, and holidays**, along with **punctuation for dates and questions**.
- Common student pitfalls include:
 - Forgetting to capitalize months, days, and holiday names.
 - Leaving out commas in dates (*Friday, December 15*).
 - Forgetting punctuation marks at the ends of sentences.
- Extension idea: Have students **write their own sentence** for a favorite holiday or birthday and trade with a partner to edit.
