Capitalization Rule to Example Answer Key

Correct Matches:

- A1 → B3 (First word of a sentence: "Can I have more pizza?")
- A2 → B1 (Proper nouns: Paris, France)
- A3 → B2 (Days/months: Friday)
- A4 → B8 (The word "I" is capitalized)
- A5 → B5 (Titles: *Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone*)
- A6 → B4 (Holiday: Thanksgiving)
- A7 → B7 (Geographic name: Mississippi River)
- A8 → B6 (Official title with name: President Lincoln)

Teacher Notes

- This activity connects **rules** directly with **examples**, helping students apply abstract guidelines to real sentences.
- Sentences cover a broad range of capitalization cases: **first words, names, titles, holidays, landmarks, and official titles.**
- Encourage students to explain why each incorrect match doesn't fit the rule.
- Extension idea: have students **write their own examples** for each rule after completing the matching.
