Effect: The laces are torn.

2. Cause: A strong wind knocked over the trash can.

Effect: Garbage spilled onto the sidewalk.

3. Cause: Carlos studied for hours and reviewed his notes carefully.

Effect: He scored the highest grade on the test.

4. Cause: The computer froze during the presentation.

Effect: The teacher restarted it.

5. Cause: Heavy rain washed away the dirt on the hill.

Fffect: Rocks rolled down onto the road.

Teacher Notes / Guide
