- The park closed because heavy rains soaked the ground and caused the river to spill over its banks.
- Two effects were playground equipment was damaged and walking trails were covered in mud and debris.
- 3. City workers put up fences and signs to keep visitors safe.
- 4. The park looked fresh and clean because the workers repaired equipment, cleared trails, and planted new grass.
- 5. When the park reopened, families rushed back, grateful to enjoy the space.
- 6. Acceptable answers may include: wildlife losing habitat, picnic areas being muddy, or roads near the park being closed.
