- 4. False This is a specific detail about volcanic danger.
- 5. **True** This also reflects the central idea: volcanoes shape Earth and provide benefits despite risks.

## **Teacher Notes / Guide**

- Emphasize that a central idea covers the whole passage, not just one sentence or fact.
- Correct answers may include more than one TRUE, because passages
  often express the central idea in more than one way (e.g., statements 1
  and 5).
- Discuss with students how details (examples, facts, effects) serve to support and illustrate the broader central idea.
