## Trait To Character Answer Key

### Part 1: Example Answers

Inside Traits: **kind, shy, brave, bossy, thoughtful, silly, honest**

Outside Traits: **tall, short, curly hair, freckles, blue shirt, glasses, messy hair**

**Part 2:** Answers will vary. Students should use at least 2 inside traits and 2 outside traits correctly.

### Teacher's Guide

- Use the trait lists to model the difference between personality traits and appearance traits before students begin.
- Encourage students to read each trait aloud and ask themselves if it describes what a person is like on the inside or what they look like on the outside.
- For differentiation, provide picture cards for students who benefit from visual supports or shorten the list for students who need fewer choices.
- For extension, have students draw the character they describe or write a short story using the character they created.
