

## Voice Match Quest Answer Key

### Correct Matches:

- C → 1. **Deep** (fits a commanding guard voice)
- B → 2. **Squeaky** (fits a frantic, high-pitched tone)
- A → 3. **Slow** (matches the drawn-out pacing of the line)
- D → 4. **Dramatic** (fits the bold, exaggerated announcement)

### Suggested Answers for Reflection Questions:

1. Answers will vary; many students may say line B (squeaky) was funniest to act out.
2. Students might struggle between A and D since both could be bold; however, A is more serious/deep, while D is more exaggerated/dramatic.
3. Voice changes add **emotion, character identity, and interest**, making reading engaging and clear for listeners.

### Teacher Notes

- This worksheet helps students connect **text clues** (word choice, pacing, tone) to **voice style**.
- Model at least one line with mismatched voices (e.g., read line C quickly) so students can see why matching matters.
- Encourage students to perform lines twice: once neutrally, then with the assigned voice, and compare.
- Extension: Have students **write one new line of dialogue** for each voice style and share with a partner.
