Dice Of Emotions Answer Key

Suggested Answers:

1. Likely “silly” or “angry” on unexpected lines (e.g., Ari whispering angrily about a missing key).
2. Yes—“Maybe it’s hidden...” said happily sounds playful, but said scared changes the mood to anxious.
3. Emotion changes help students practice **tone, flexibility, and expression**, which strengthens fluency and audience engagement.

Teacher Notes

- Model one line with different emotions to show how delivery changes tone.
- This activity emphasizes **expressive adaptability**: students see that words can sound very different depending on emotion.
- Encourage laughter and creativity; even “wrong” matches (e.g., happy when sad) help students explore fluency.
- Extension idea: Have students **write two extra lines** for any character, then roll the dice to perform them.
