Guess That Character Answer Key

Correct Voice Matches:

- **Grandma Lotte** → warm, firm, slightly older-sounding tone.
- **Theo** → mischievous, playful, eager tone.
- **Nina** → cautious, worried, gentle tone.
- **Narrator** → neutral, steady, descriptive tone.

Suggested Answers for Reflection:

1. Grandma Lotte may be easiest because her "firm but caring" tone stands out.
2. Nina may be harder since a worried voice can sound similar to cautious or quiet tones.
3. Voice changes highlight character personality and emotions, making comprehension and engagement stronger.

Teacher Notes

- Model each voice once before the activity so students understand how tone and style reflect character traits.
- Stress that the **narrator** should remain steady and neutral, unlike the expressive character voices.
- This activity promotes both **expressive reading** and **active listening**.
- Extension: Students can create their own extra line for one character and challenge classmates to guess.
