Teacher's Guide

- Quick implementation: Model how to transfer information from a scenario to the correct check fields before students begin.
- Differentiation: Let students underline the date, payee, amount, and purpose in each scenario before completing the check.
- Differentiation: For extra support, allow students to use a number-to-word reference for larger dollar amounts.
- Engagement: Have partners compare completed checks and check each field for accuracy.
- Extension: Ask students to create a sixth payment scenario and complete a check for it.
