- 4. She walked to school.
- 5. The movie was fun.

Step 2 - Word Power! - Now, ask Claude:

"Can you give me two more versions of this sentence using stronger words?"

Then, circle or underline the words Claude changed that made the biggest difference.

Step 3 - Fix the Flaws - Here are some sentences that have mistakes.

Ask Claude to correct and improve each one 3 different ways.:

- 1. The book were very interesting.
- 2. Him and me is going to the park.
- 3. Their going to sea a movie.
- 4. The cake smell really goodly.
