Who *Really* Made Claude?

Claude AI was created by a company called **Anthropic** (pronounced "an-THROH-pic"). Anthropic is a research company in the United States that focuses on building artificial intelligence that is **safe, helpful, and responsible**.

Anthropic was founded in **2021** by two siblings, **Dario Amodei** and **Daniela Amodei**, along with several other researchers who had worked at another AI company before. They wanted to start a new kind of company—one that made powerful AI systems while also protecting people and keeping things fair and safe.

One of Anthropic's most interesting ideas is something called **Constitutional AI**. This means that Claude has a kind of "rulebook" it follows when giving answers. These rules, or "constitution," help Claude stay kind, truthful, and careful about what it says.

Over time, Anthropic has made new versions of Claude that can read longer texts, answer more detailed questions, and create more creative writing.

Anthropic is also a **Public Benefit Corporation**, which means it tries to balance earning money with doing good things for the world. In short, Claude is not magic—it's the result of thoughtful work by people who want technology to help humanity.
