Mark-Ups (Possible Answers):

- Repeated Word: Restless (lines 2–3). The repetition emphasizes the boy's unease and mirrors the rushing river.
- Striking Phrase: "the bridge seemed endless in the dark." This is powerful because it captures both fear and the challenge of moving forward in uncertainty.
- **Unusual Detail**: The boy whispering "restless" back to the river. This detail is unusual because it shows him treating nature as if it could speak, adding mystery and personification.

Questions - Model Answers:

- 1. The repeated word is *restless*. It reflects the river's movement and the boy's unsettled feelings.
- 2. One possible striking phrase is "the bridge seemed endless in the dark." It conveys the depth of his fear and the atmosphere of uncertainty.
- 3. An unusual detail is the boy whispering the word "restless" as if answering the river. It creates a haunting, imaginative mood.
- 4. The larger theme may suggest facing fears, crossing into the unknown, or the tension between hesitation and courage.

Teacher Notes:

- Encourage students to defend *their own choices* of words or phrases if different from the key.
- The purpose of this worksheet is not "one right answer," but training students to notice how repetition, phrasing, and details shape meaning.
- Extension: Have students write one more sentence to continue the passage, using at least one repeated word or striking phrase of their own.
